## 1. Introduction

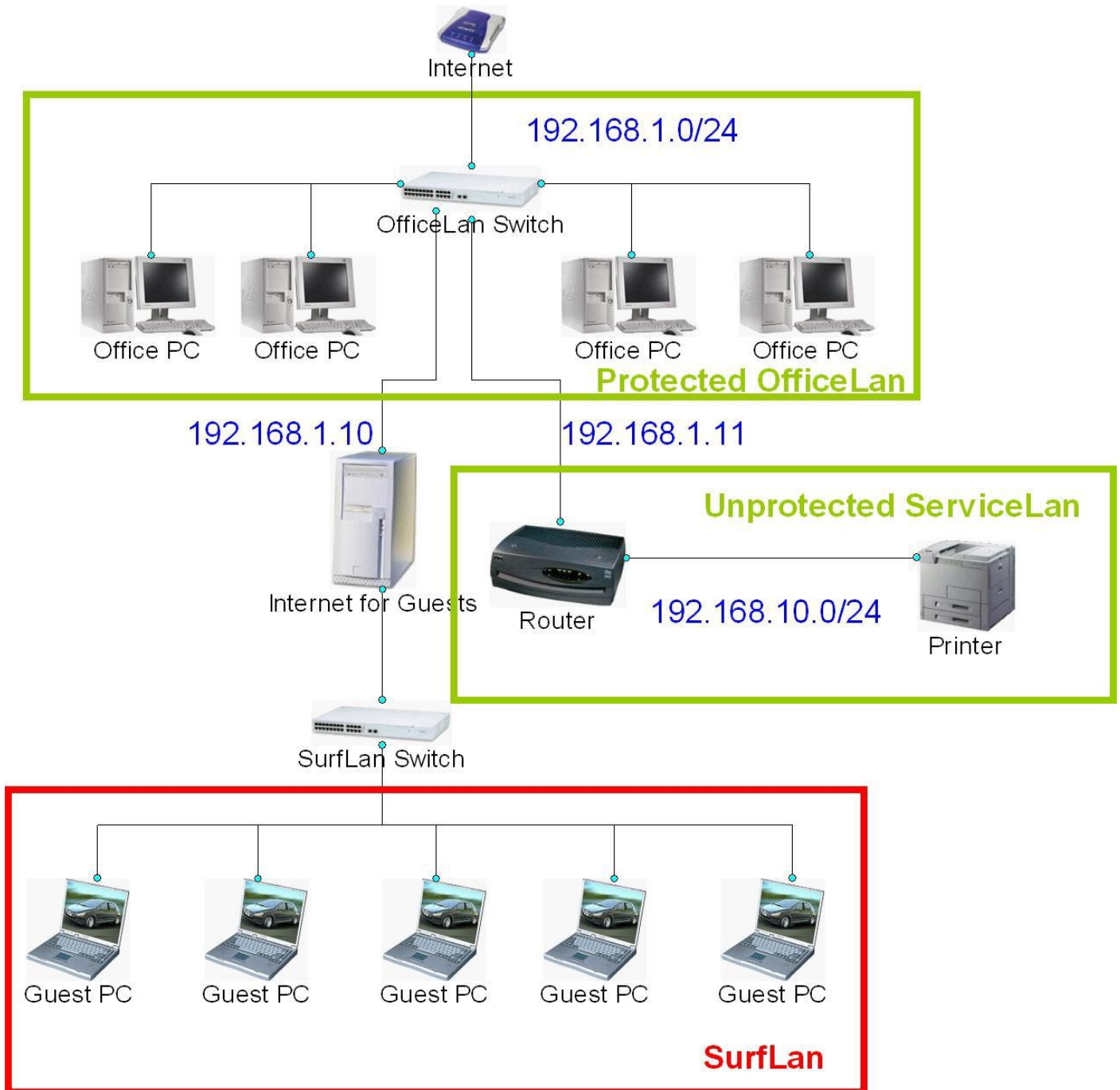

1. Your customers still have to install a printer driver
2. All devices, in the ServiceLan, can be reached from all devices out of the SurfLan
3. To be able to print, the customer must have internet access and therefore must be logged on to IAC-BOX

Set up a ServiceLan, as shown in the following picture.

In IAC-BOX WebAdmin switch to menu **Security/Routes** and create a new route to the ServiceLan as showed in the following picture.
