This HowTo shows how to create your required PayPal Account and how to configure your IACBOX to use this feature.


## 2. PayPal Account

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### 2.1 Create Account

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Visit the PayPal website <http://www.paypal.com> and click **Sign Up**. You can choose between three different account types.

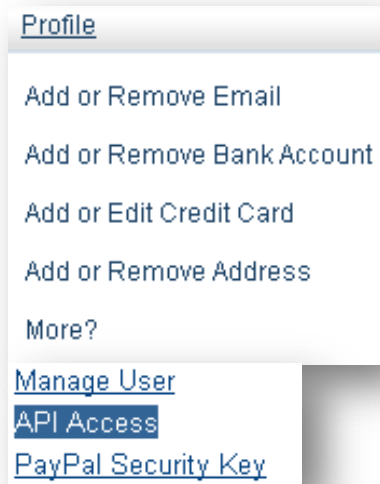

## 2.2 API Configuration

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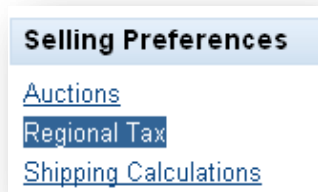
Log In to your PayPal account you have created right now.



Select menu **My Account** -> **Profile** and then **More**.

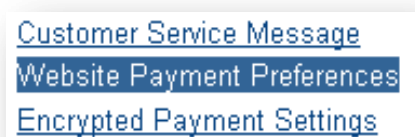
Select **API Access** in menu **Account Information**

Create an **API Permission** by using **Option 2** und save the created **API Signature** information into a text file.



Switch back to **Profile Summary** and select option **Regional Tax** in menu **Selling Preferences**. This option is not available in all countries. If not available in your country skip this step.

Disable Sales Tax of your country because IAC-BOX already sends gross prices by default.



Switch back to **Profile Summary** and select **Website Payment Preferences** in menu **Selling Preferences**.

Verify that option **Auto Return** is disabled. If not disable the Auto Return option.

**OPTIONAL:** PayPal allows you to customize your PayPal payment website. This can be found in **Custom Payment Pages** in menu **Selling Preferences**.


## 3. IACBOX Configuration

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### 3.1 Online Payment configuration

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Login to IAC-BOX WebAdmin interface as user **sysop** and switch to menu **Modules -> Online Payment**.

- Select **PayPal** as Online Payment Provider.
- Use PayPal **API Username** as **Username** as created in step 2.2.
- Use PayPal **API Password** as **Password** as created in step 2.2.
- Use PayPal **Signature** as Signature as created in step 2.2.

Save the settings.

## 3.2 Select tickets for use with PayPal

If the **Online Payment** module is configured completely you can activate the checkbox **Online Payment** for ticket templates of your choice in menu **Tickets -> Templates**. All ticket templates which have Online Payment enabled will be visible to the guests.
